



The project has been awarded funding to develop detailed proposals for further funding bids.

Funding bids to both Heritage Lottery Fund and Historic Environment Scotland are due to be submitted by autumn 2018 with decisions expected by the end of the year. If the funding bids are successful a programme of improvement works will be rolled out focussing on the High Street.

Grants will become available for the following:

- Shopfront Improvement grants may assist with the cost of works like re-instating traditional timber shopfront windows and doors. Improving signage and security measures.
- Small grants scheme will be available to owners of commercial and non-commercial space to carry out repairs to roofs, chimneys, rainwater goods (gutters/ rones and downpipes), external decoration, windows and doors.
- Grants for vacant shops may assist with the cost of shopfront improvements (as noted above) and with the cost of upgrading heating, electrics, plumbing and basic decoration.

Works will also include improvements to the road and pavements between the Town Hall and Castle.

The Maybole Regeneration Project is aiming to invest up to £6M in the buildings and streetscape of Maybole High Street.

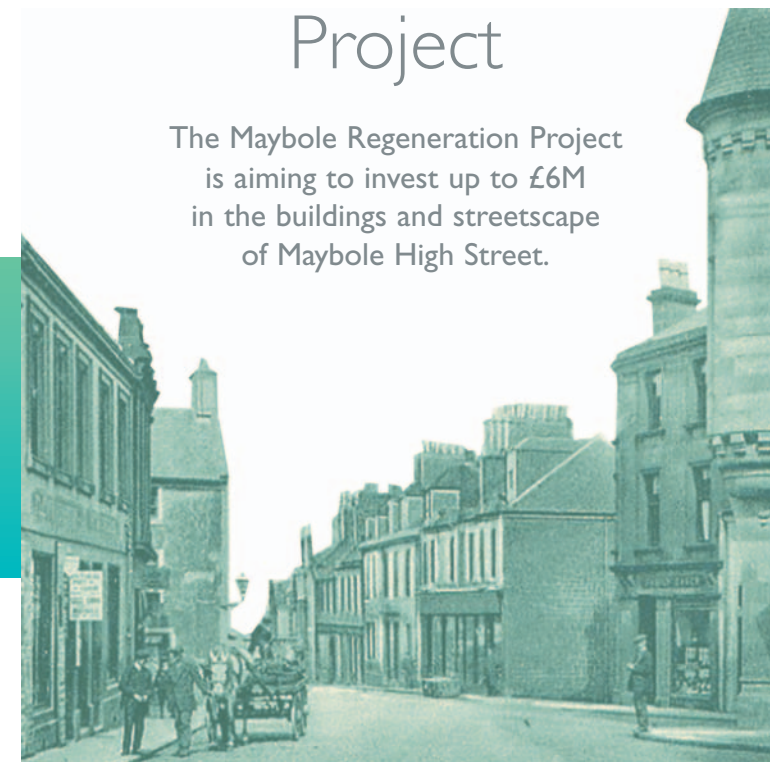


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Maybole Regeneration Project Focus Area
